Gilman, IL-Arthur R. Haug Jr., 74, of Gilman, IL, formerly of Plymouth, IN, passed away Monday, January 2, 2012 in Watseka, IL. Mr. Haug was born in Chicago on October 5, 1937 to Arthur and Florence (Goze) Haug. At an early age, his family moved to Plymouth from Chicago.
