



## Bart A. Rodgers

Grovertown – Bart A. Rodgers, 55 of Grovertown, Indiana passed away on Thursday February 13, 2020 at Starke Hospital following a sudden illness. He was born on August 11, 1964 in Knox, Indiana to the late Guy and Faye (Conley) Rodgers, both whom precede his death, and lived in the area all of his life.

He was a member of the Starke County Sheriff Department Posey, a former Washington Township Volunteer Firefighter, was active with the Starke County 4-H Fair Horse and Pony Club, and was widely known as everyone's favorite concrete mixer driver working with Ozinga Concrete for over 30 years.
