Bonita Ann "Bonnie" Davis of Grovetown, IN (formerly of Stilesville, IN) passed away peacefully in her sleep on Monday, July 28, 2025, after a courageous battle with cancer. She was born on July 30, 1943, to Maude F. (Vise) and Clare Gorham, both who preceded her in death.

Bonnie was one of five children: Nancy Pinkerton, Doris Shuler, Steve Gorham and Samuel (Irene) Gorham. Beloved sister Doris preceded her in death as well as two brothers-in-law Floyd Pinkerton and Paul Robert Shuler, as well as nephew Brian Shuler.
