KOONTZ LAKE – Chad M. Sult passed away on Saturday, February 26, 2022 in Memorial Hospital, South Bend following a sudden illness. He was born on November 23, 1973 in LaPorte to the late Dennis Sult and Connie (Daniels) Sult, and was 48 years-old at the time of his death.

Chad was the definition of a free spirit who traveled and lived wherever life took him. He graduated from Oregon-Davis High School and went on to be a Barber. He had a smile and laugh that would light up any room he entered. Chad was an avid outdoorsman who was also quick to help anyone who needed it by giving them his last dollar or the shirt off of his back. This was exhibited even at the end as he gave the precious gift of life to a number of strangers through organ donation.

Chad is survived by: his loving mother Connie Sult of Walkerton; one brother James (Monica) Sult of Quanah, TX; two nieces Kierstyn and Katelyn; one uncle Terry Daniels; and one aunt Phyllis (Bill) Hullinger.

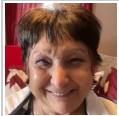
