Charles Robert Schnekenburger claimed his eternal reward on the beautiful Sunday morning of August 16, 2020. Chuck, born on September 18, 1964 was the son of the late Charles Schnekenburger, the late Harold Schroeder, and Lola Schroeder, who survives.

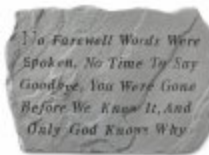
