



## Charles & Patricia Hill IV

North Judson - Charles W. Hill IV, 44, and his wife, Patricia (Crum) Hill, 44, were married on February 10, 2004 in Clark Co., Nevada. On Tuesday, April 14, 2015, near North Judson, IN, they died together, the result of an automobile/motorcycle accident.

Charles was born October 10, 1970 in Oak Lawn, IL to Charles and Jeannette (Iverson) Hill III. He was an ironworker for the Iron Workers Local 63 of Chicago. He was retired from the U.S. Army Reserves of Kingsbury, IN, a member of the American Legion, Sons of The American Legion, the VFW, and was a volunteer for Pop Warner Football in North Judson.

Survivors include two daughters, Melonie (Nathan) Novello of Walkerton and Brandi Roberts of North Liberty; two sons, Corey Scott of Plymouth and Charles W.
