Walkerton – Cheryl J. Flaughter, age 87, passed away on Tuesday May 12 at Miller’s Merry Manor, Walkerton following an illness. She was born on August 13, 1932 in South Bend to the late Robert and Opal (Lawrence) Hostetler and lived in the area her entire life.

On June 11, 1955 in Walkerton she married Robert Flaughter who also precedes her death. Cheryl was a retired Administrative Assistant at the University of Notre Dame, a lifelong member of the Walkerton United Methodist Church, a member of the Walkerton United Methodist Church Women’s, the Walkerton Historical Society, the American Legion Post 189 Auxiliary, the Walkerton Business and Professional Women, and the Eastern Star.
