WALKERTON-Chester Stiegal, 75, passed away Monday, January 24, 2011 in Millers Merry Manor, Walkerton, IN. Mr. Stiegal was born August 2, 1935 in Chicago and lived in the area for twenty-five years, coming from Chicago. On June 15, 1957 in Chicago, he was married to the former Mary T. Reilly. Survivors include his wife, Mary; one daughter, Kathleen (John) Carter of North Liberty; two sons, Mark Stiegal of Wheaton, IL and Charles Stiegal of Koontz Lake; six grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren and one sister, Lorraine Stiegal of Illinois. He was preceded in death by one son, John Stiegal; his parents and his step-father, Casimir Mazur.

Mr. Stiegal was a retired Chicago Police Officer, serving for twenty-eight years. He was a U.S. Army veteran and a member of the FOP Lodge #7, Chicago and the Retired Chicago Police Association.
