Dennis R. Goble Sr., of Hamlet, passed away on Tuesday, April 14, 2026, at Brickyard Healthcare, surrounded by his loving family. Born on March 23, 1948, in Knox, he was the son of the late Chester and Dolma (Jensen) Goble. He was 78 years old at the time of his passing.
