ROCHESTER – Dorothy K. “Dolly” Ewing passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, December 7, 2023 following an illness. She was born on September 12, 1950 in East Chicago to the late John J. Patrick and Dorothy E. (Schneider) Coad and was 73 years-old at the time of her death.
