



## Fletcher Sherland

April 11, 1933 - July 18, 2020

Fletcher Sherland of Walkerton passed away on Saturday July 18, 2020 in Miller's Merry Manor, Plymouth following an illness. He was born on April 11, 1933 in Plymouth to the late Lawrence Sherland and Elsie (Kusky) Thomas and was 87 years-old at the time of his death.

He lived in the Walkerton area since moving from Chicago in 1953 and was a retired electrician with the Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Union.
