WALKERTON – Frederick W. “Pudder” Kulbieda passed away unexpectedly on Tuesday, April 23, 2024, in his home. He was born on June 11, 1945, in Chicago to the late Walter and Anna (Kwas) Kulbieda and was 78 years-old at the time of his death.

Fred was a retired Steel Worker, retiring from Union Electric Steel in Valparaiso. He lived in the area most of his life. He was a devout Catholic and was a member of the Holy Cross Catholic Church in Hamlet. Fred was also an avid sports fan, especially of the Chicago Bears and Chicago Cubs.

Fred is survived by his son Christopher of Warsaw; one brother Richard (Joann) Kulbieda of Arizona; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents.
