Grovertown - Fredonna C. Bergstrom, 93, passed away Sunday, April 12, 2015 at Millers Merry Manor, Culver, IN.

Fredonna was born October 11, 1921, in Tyner, IN, to Orra and Vivian (Brooke) Lemert and lived in the area all of her life.
