



James Lee Campbell

July 3, 1940 - September 16, 2021

WINAMAC – James Lee Campbell of Winamac, formerly of Hamlet, passed away on Thursday, September 16, 2021 in his home. He was born on July 3, 1940 to the late Newton Daniel and Golden Day (Martin) Campbell in Bulen, KY and was 81 years-old at the time of his death.

In September 1968 he married Judith Fay Childers who survives. Also surviving are five sons Jeffrey Alan Campbell of LaPorte, Tommy Campbell of Grovertown, David Dwight (Denise) Campbell of Grovertown, Gary Dwain (Erlyn) Campbell of LaPorte, and Lance Eric (Wendy) Campbell of Winamac; three daughters Carol Sue Geller of Grovertown, Susan Renee Campbell of LaPorte, and Beth Ann Campbell of North Judson. James would always point to his children, 26 grandchildren, and 24 great-grandchildren and say “There goes the rest of me”. He is preceded in death by his parents; two brothers Leonard and Tommy; and 3 sisters Bertha, Margaret, and Joyce.

James served honorably in the US Marine Corps for four years. He was an extremely proud American and former Marine. He worked for the railroad until becoming disabled. After his career with the railroad, he served as a reserve employee for the Starke and Jasper County Sherriff’s Departments, and for the DeMotte City Police. He was an avid fisherman and enjoyed fishing for northern pike with his sons.

He will forever be remembered for his great love for his family, his country, his

booming voice and laugh, his handlebar moustache, and the man with a million jokes.
