KNOX-James W. Jenkins Sr., 98, passed away Sunday, March 5, 2017 at Golden Living Center, Knox, IN.

James was born June 22, 1918 in Honolulu, HI to Robert and Lucille (Machado) Jenkins and lived in the area for 65 years, coming from California. He was a retired painter.
