Jeff was very proud that he and Kim followed the route that the American soldiers took to free Europe from the rule of Hitler. Jeff was also a big fan of the Marx brothers and the Three Stooges. He could make anyone laugh with his antics. One of the funnest things I ever saw him do was when we were working at Sobenite and an operator complained about the press she was running saying it going to fast. Jeff took her by the arm told her if she didn't like it she should go home. He escorted her to an exit, opened the door and pushed her out in to the snow shutting the "EXIT ONLY" door. I was the foreman and saw him do it. We were having a blizzard and when I opened the door Bernise, covered with snow was laughing so hard she had peed her pants. When Jeff met Kim he told me "That's the girl I am going to marry". I told him "Be careful, she eats crackers in bed". I then had to explain, very quickly, that Kim and my youngest sister were best friends and that while I was away at camp Kim stay over night with my sister Julayne, both were about 6 years old, and my mom let them sleep in my room. Jeff was the best friend I ever had and I will miss him forever.
