WALKERTON-Judith (Judy) Raye Ceerle, 71, of Walkerton, Indiana, passed away in her home, surrounded by her family on June 2, 2018. Judy was born in LaHarpe, Illinois, to Robert Logan and Lila Lee (Scott) Correll who preceded her in death.

Judy is survived by her husband of 49 years, Samuel Ceerle; son, Bryan Ceerle; daughter, Heather Ceerle who all reside at home; brothers Harold (Rebecca) Correll of Georgia; R. Vance Correll of Walkerton; Dewitt (Mindy) Correll of Anderson; sister-in-law Deborah (Greg) Bolinger of Lafayette, and numerous nieces and nephews. Judy was preceded in death by her brother Roy LaVerne Correll.

Judy loved her family and her children were her pride and joy. Judy was a member of the Fulton County Historical Society where she was a co-contributor, condensing and editing the 1838 Trail of Death Diary as part of the 150th Anniversary publication and 1988 caravan retracing the trail. She was also a member of the Fulton County Indian Awareness group. She enjoyed attending the numerous rendezvous', festivals, and activities associated with each until she was no longer able to attend.

Judy worked for nearly 18 years at the Plymouth Hospital (SJRMC) as a Respiratory Therapist, Cardiopulmonary Tech, and ER Admissions Clerk; as an AutoCAD Assistant at ESI; and lastly as an Office Assistant at JFNew before she retired in 2013. Of all the jobs she had in her life, her most prized job title was MOM.

Funeral services will be Thursday, June 7, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. EDT at Rannells Funeral Home, Koontz Lake Chapel. Burial will follow at the Grovertown Cemetery.
