April 20, 1944 - October 15, 2022

HAMLET – Karen M. Neville, a lifelong resident of Hamlet, passed away on Saturday, October 15, 2022. She was born in LaPorte on April 20, 1944 to the late Vincent “Bink” and Florence (Rittenhouse) Neville. She was 78 years-old at the time of her death.

Karen graduated from Hamlet High School in 1962 and was well known from her banking career where she worked for 39 years as a Bookkeeper and Teller for the Hamlet State Bank which became 1st Source Bank in Hamlet.
