



## LaVerne M. Dini

May 8, 1922 - April 26, 2013

KOONTZ LAKE-LaVerne M.Dini, 90, passed away Friday, April 26, 2013 in Indianapolis, IN. LaVerne M. Dini (Marshall) was born at home on May 8, 1922 in Chicago, IL. She was the sixth child of John and Emma (Harder) Marshall.

LaVerne graduated from Calumet H.S. in Chicago and began a varied career as an elevator operator at Marshall Field's, a bookkeeper, a bank account auditor and she provided transport for handicapped students. During WWII, LaVerne moved to Dayton, OH to work for the Army Air Corp at Wright Patterson Air Force Base.

In 1947, LaVerne married William C. Dini. They made their home first in Chicago and then at Koontz Lake, IN. They were the loving parents of Joyce (Tom) Egan, William D. Dini, and Elizabeth (Jim) Aelick. She was also the proud grandmother of William Aelick, her special helper. In addition to her immediate family, LaVerne is survived by many nieces, nephews, cousins, friends and her loving caregivers at Millers in Indianapolis. She was preceded in death by her husband and her siblings, Gertrude, George, John, Joseph, Rose Mary and Mildred. LaVerne had lived at Millers Senior Living Community in Indianapolis since 2009 and served as the president of the Residents' Council.

Funeral services will be Saturday, May 4, 2013 at 1:00 p.m. (Central Time) in Rannells Funeral Home, Koontz Lake Chapel. Burial will follow at the Woodlawn Cemetery, Walkerton.
