Chicago; and six greatgrandchildren Emma Egger, Olivia Egger, Kendall Egger, Zane Egger, Durham Egger, and Gatlin Egger. She is preceded in death by her parents; husband; two brothers Howard Stuntz and Hayward Stuntz; and one sister Elnora Soales.
