



## Maurice J. "Jack" Gallois

HAMLET – Maurice J. “Jack” Gallois of Hamlet, formerly of Chicago, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Tuesday, November 26, 2024 following an illness. He was born on May 15, 1933 in Chicago to the late Maurice and Lena (Arndt) Gallois Sr., and was 91 years-old at the time of his death.

Jack had lived in Hamlet for the last two years coming from Chicago. He was a retired Carpenter, and on May 6, 1972 in Chicago he married Roseann Neville.
