Michael Douglas "Yak" Yakimicki, a resident of LaPorte, Indiana since 1996 and formerly of Grovertown, passed away August 13, 2016, at Hospice Franciscan Communities at St. Anthony Health in Michigan City, Indiana, of kidney cancer. He was 67 years old at the time of his death.
