GROVERTOWN – Raymond McCarty, 99 years-old of Grovertown passed away at home on Wednesday, February 17, 2021. He was born on December 8, 1921 in Walkerton to the late Isaac and Pearl (Swagart) McCarty and lived in the area his entire life.
