Richard L. Parker, 84, of Walkerton, gained his heavenly wings on Monday, March 10, 2025, at St. Joseph Regional Medical Center in Plymouth following an illness. Born on April 19, 1940, in Hammond, he was the son of the late Homer "H. Roy" and Gertrude (Heeter) Parker.
