.KNOX – Robert R. “Bob” Trigg of Knox passed away on Thursday, November 9, 2023. He was born on April 12, 1927 in Ober, IN to the late William S. and Louise (Borchardt) Trigg, and was 96 years old at the time of his death. He lived in the area his entire life. Bob married the love of his life Gerry (Emigh) Trigg on June 5, 1948 in Knox. He was a Veteran of the US Army Air Force serving during WWII and was a member of the Knox American Legion Post #131. He started the Culver High School Building Trades program where he was the first instructor for 14 years and served on the Building Trades Advisory Board for 29 years. Most of all Bob cherished his family dearly. . Bob is survived by his loving wife Gerry of Knox; four children Dennis (Esther) Trigg of Rice Lake, WI, Denise (Dennis) Pitts of Knox, Dr. David (Karen) Trigg of Greenwood, and Dee Ann (Greg) Keehn of Knox; thirteen grandchildren; twenty great grandchildren; one great-great grandchild; and one sister Rose Ann Eichelberg of Knox. He is preceded in death by his parents and one brother James Trigg.
