KNOX – Ruby F. Torok passed away on Monday, November 2, 2020. She was born on May 29, 1918 in Knox to the late Oscar and Lucy (Tietz) Fechner and was 102 years-old at the time of her death.

She lived in the area all of her life and was a retired secretary. On October 6, 1940 she married the love of her life, the late Edward Torok in Knox. She was a member of the Knox Historical Society, the Knox United Methodist Church, and the North Bend Township Home Bureau Club where she served as President. She was a former member of the Ladies Farm Bureau and served as an election poll sheriff for many years. She was also a member of the Good Time Fellow Singers.

Ruby is survived by: one daughter Melody (Bob) Coffin of Knox; one granddaughter Estelle (Jeremiah) Carr of Huntersville, NC; two grandsons Kevin (Priscilla) Falk of Knox and Brian (Michal Joy) Falk of Argos; and five great-grandchildren Isabella, Warren, Evelyn, Owen, and Colton.
