



## Samuel D. Soltis Sr.

June 27, 1942 - May 24, 2024

PLYMOUTH – Samuel D. Soltis Sr. of rural Plymouth passed away on Friday, May 24, 2024 in his home following a lengthy illness. He was born on June 27, 1942 in Hammond to the late Samuel S. and Mary M. (Giecko) Soltis and was 81 years old at the time of his death.
