WALKERTON-Scott D. Drotar, 30, passed away peacefully at his home on Tuesday, January 24, 2017.

Scott was born September 10, 1986 in Rochester, IN to Daniel and Elizabeth (Krick) Drotar.

Scott was a lifelong learner, receiving his bachelor's degree in mathematics from the University of Notre Dame and his master's degree in analytical psychology from the University of Kansas.
