WALKERTON – Thomas G. “Pa” Dollahan passed away on Thursday, November 2, 2023 in his home following an illness. He was born on September 2, 1929 in Bass Lake to the late Richard and Marry (Scott) Dollahan and was 94 years-old at the time of his death.
