PLYMOUTH – Warren Ray Allen of Plymouth, formerly of Walkerton, passed away on Saturday September 19, 2020 in Memorial Hospital, South Bend following an illness. He was born on May 30, 1935 in Paintsville, KY to the late William and Minnie Allen and was 85 years-old at the time of his death.

He lived in the area most of his life, and on June 12, 1954 in Grovertown he married the love of his life Mary Ann Erickson, who also precedes his death. Warren retired from a career as a welder for New York Blower and served for many years as the Oregon Township Trustee.
