KNOX-Wayne C. Singleton, 92, passed away Tuesday, August 2, 2011 in his home after a brief illness. Mr. Singleton was born March 28, 1919 in Davis Township, IN to Charles and Gladys (Coffin) Singleton and lived in the area all of his life.
