Włodzimierz K. Wolski passed away peacefully on Monday, January 13, 2025, in Miller's Merry Manor, Culver following an illness. He was born on January 5, 1954, in Poland to the late Władysław and Józefa Wolski and was 71 years-old at the time of his death.

He lived at Koontz Lake the last 6-7 years coming from Galesburg, IL and was a retired Master Craftsman. Włodzimierz took great pride in the musical instruments he created, which included large harps. He was also a nature lover who especially enjoyed gardening and tending to his fruit trees. Most of all Włodzimierz cherished his family dearly.
